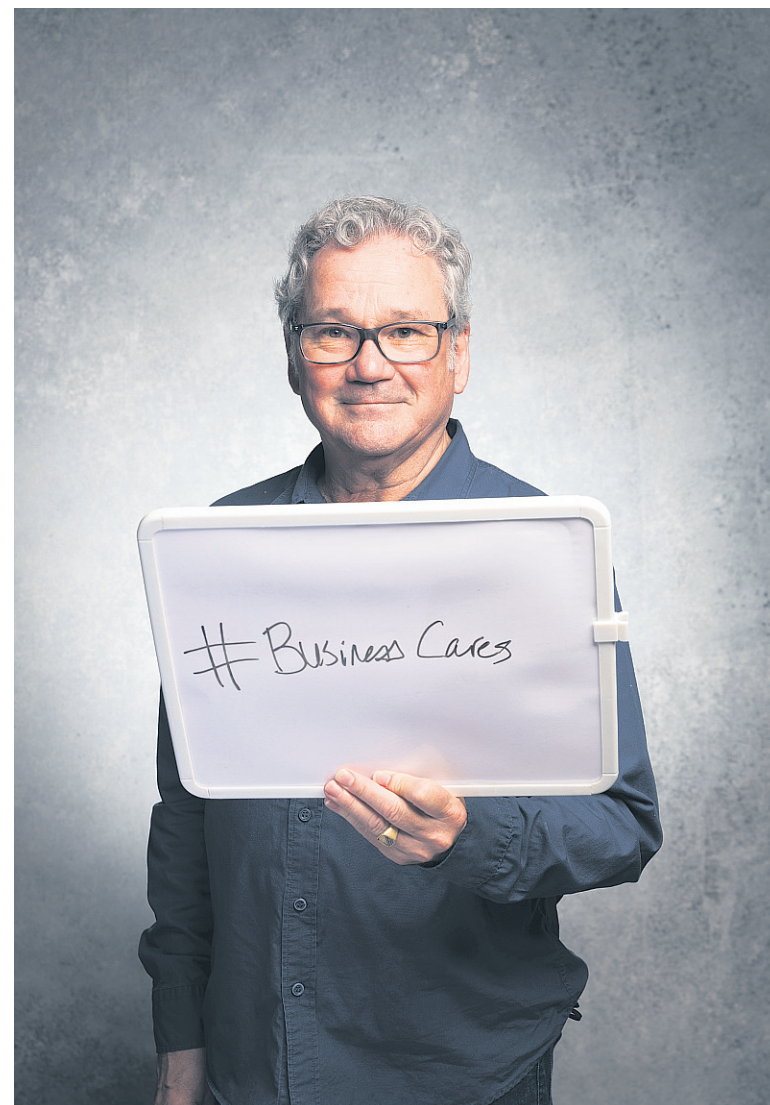
# Community Leaders show their support

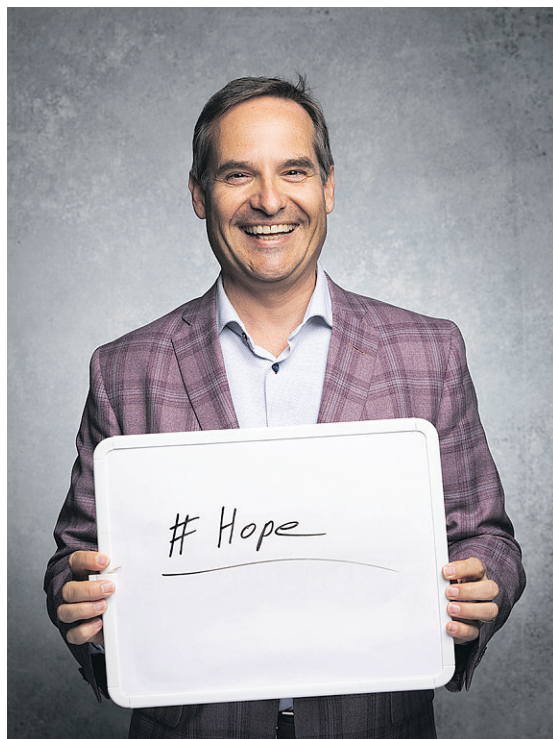

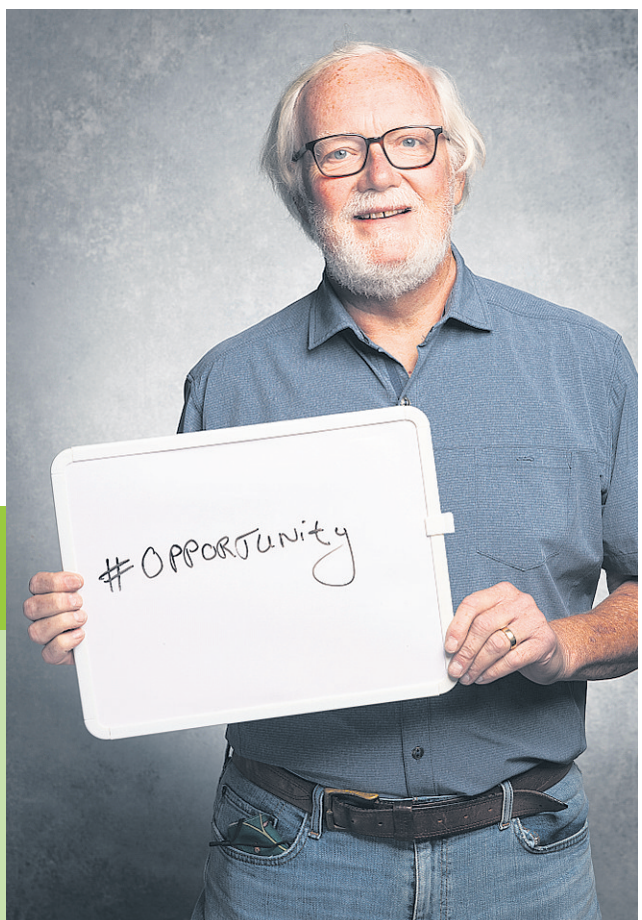
