What will you learn?

This Transport Canada accredited Bridge Watch Rating (BWR) program provides hands-on entry-level training required for those who would like to work as deckhands in the marine industry. This program is a prerequisite to work as a deckhand on vessels over 500 gross tonnage with major tug and barge employers.

Students will obtain the following certificates: Transport Canada Bridge Watch Rating training certificate, Small Vessel Operator Proficiency (SVOP), Marine Basic First Aid (MBFA), STCW Basic Safety Training (BST), STCW Proficiency in Survival Craft (PSC), WHMIS and Restricted Operator's Certificate – Maritime Commercial (ROC MC). The program is in partnership with BCIT and your BST and PSC training will be completed at the BCIT North Vancouver Marine Campus.

Who is eligible?

Women and Indigenous learners who are Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents are eligible for fully subsidized tuition and other direct costs for the Enhanced Bridge Watch Rating program.
