Local politicians join Our Place to serve over 1,000 Easter meals to the city's homeless and working poor on April. 17

VICTORIA, B.C. – Local politicians will be joining Our Place volunteers and staff to make everyone feel like family this Easter.

Around 1,000 of Victoria's most vulnerable citizens are expected to join Our Place's family table for a special Easter meal on Thursday, April 17 through the generous support of donors, community groups and volunteers. Local politicians and special guests will be rolling up their sleeves to dish out a full meal of turkey, potatoes, garden veg and all the trimmings.

"Easter is a time of transformation, celebration and belonging," says Don Evans, executive director of Our Place. "Serving a special meal to those who might otherwise go without is just one small way of showing that we are here to listen, share and support."

The kitchen at Our Place expects to serve a hearty meal consisting of 1,000 lbs of turkey, 500 lbs of potatoes, 250 lbs of stuffing, 200 lbs of vegetables, 25 gallons of gravy, 55 lbs of cranberry sauce and 1,500 cups of coffee.
